These scholarships cover University tuition, accommodation, and upkeep of the awardees. This is in line with the Foundation's commitment to supporting academically distinguished students.

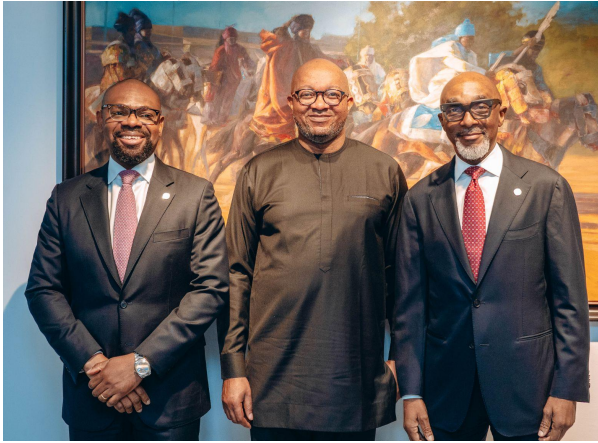
Foundation Activities
